Dues cover or partially cover the following:

- Monthly phone bill
- Web services
- CPA who fills out our form 990
- Postage: send out grant reimbursement checks, fund raise for all schools, meeting minutes to absent coordinators
- Toner for copy machine
- Toner for fax machine
- Paper for both machines
- Hardcopy of MCPP/G Handbook: contents, folder, given at no charge
- Supplies like paper clips, staples, data stick, envelopes, checks, name tags
- On occasion, refreshments for our June meeting

Sometimes there is a fee to register MCPP/G as a non-profit charitable organization Much depends on the money that is raised whether there is a yearly fee or not

Vendor fair registration fees generally cover the following:

- Room rental
- Printing of vendor directory
- Invitations to vendors
- Interdepartmental mail is used to advertise to and invite the public schools
- MCPP/G relies on the post prom coordinators to help with advertising
- Independent schools would receive an invitation via regular mail

Any carry over is saved to cover unexpected expenses and to get started for the next fiscal year. Fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30.
